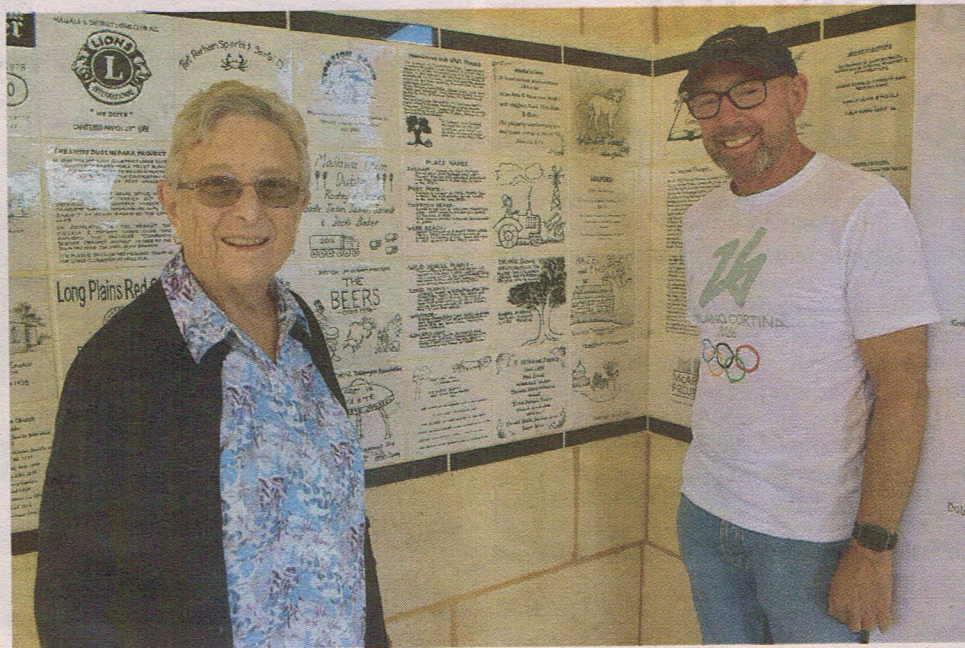


150th Anniversary Celebration Weekend

Dorene Jean Young with Peter Young near the tile with some family information in the Schlodder Shelter at Dublin. (539362)



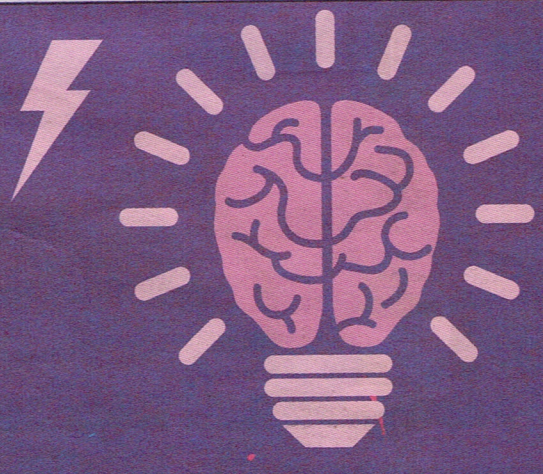
Peter Prime and Sandy Connell from Ovingham. Originally from Dublin, Peter has family connections to the area. (539365)
